The building as a whole will provide employment for up to 100 people.

WHO ARE WE?

PROJECT BOILERHOUSE brings together Sunny Bank Mills, Trouble at Mill Events and people from the wider community of West Leeds.

SUNNY BANK MILLS is a 10 acre site that is being regenerated through bringing together business and culture. The existing Gallery and Arts programme has supported over 500 artists in the past 6 years through staging more than 50 exhibitions. 21 studio spaces currently support local artists and makers.

The project sees us renovate one of the earliest mill buildings, which dates back to 1830. It puts this currently unused site back at the heart of Sunny Bank Mills.

Based in Farsley, **TROUBLE AT MILL** has a ten year history of delivering critically acclaimed shows and events, building a loyal and varied audience rooted in the local community. This has included a series of sell-out pop up events at Sunny Bank Mills, bringing together music, theatre, comedy, opera and food. They also run popular 100-capacity venue The Constitutional.
